

## CODE OF CONDUCT/BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES:

- >No riding in vehicles unless it is an OEC approved one
- >You must notify a staff member and travel in groups of 3 when leaving the hotel
- >You will be expected to be in your assigned hotel rooms by 12 midnight.
- >You will be expected to attend classes at all times when you are not participating in a competition.
- >You will be expected to attend OEC/IRECA-related scheduled meetings/events
- >You are representing the OEC Program and the state of Minnesota and will be expected to act professional at all times.
- >No outsiders will be permitted in hotel rooms.
